Utilize saw timber to a 10" minimum top diameter, pulp to a 4" minimum top diameter. Protect all residual timber (especially hemlock and white pine) from damage. Use Wisconsin BMPs for Water Quality for all road and trail construction. No harvest from 1 April to 30 June. No equipment in wetlands or streams unless ground is frozen and/or > 12" snow. 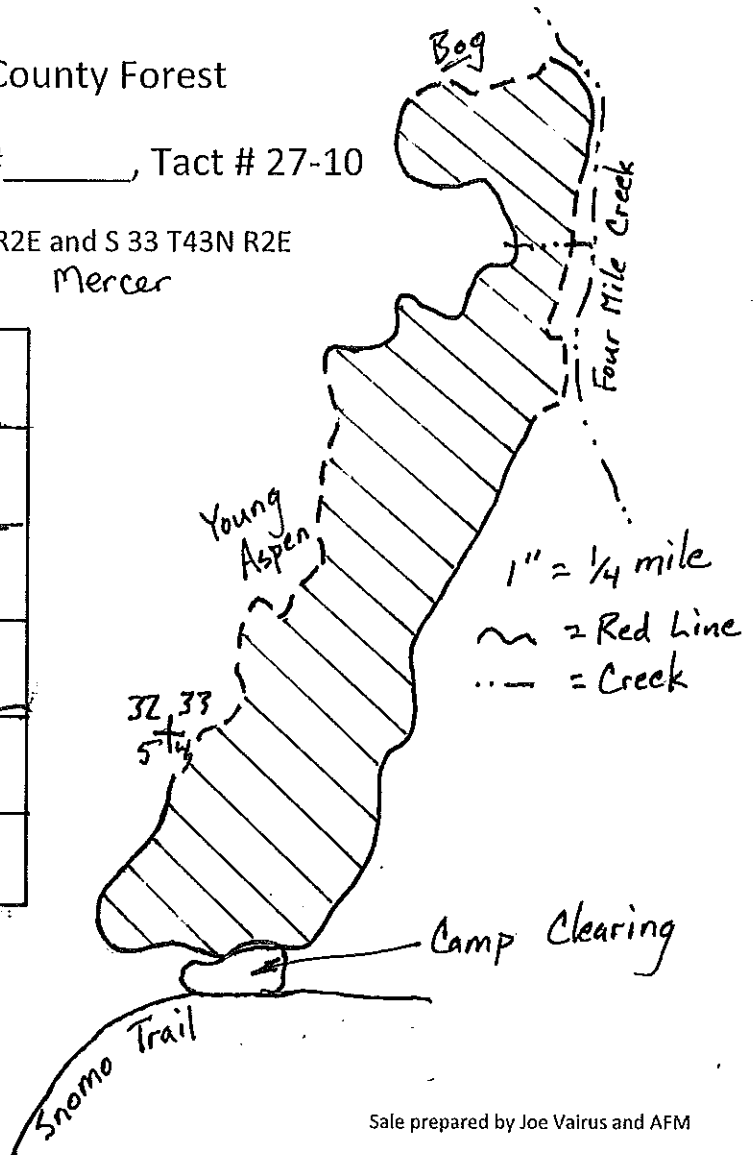
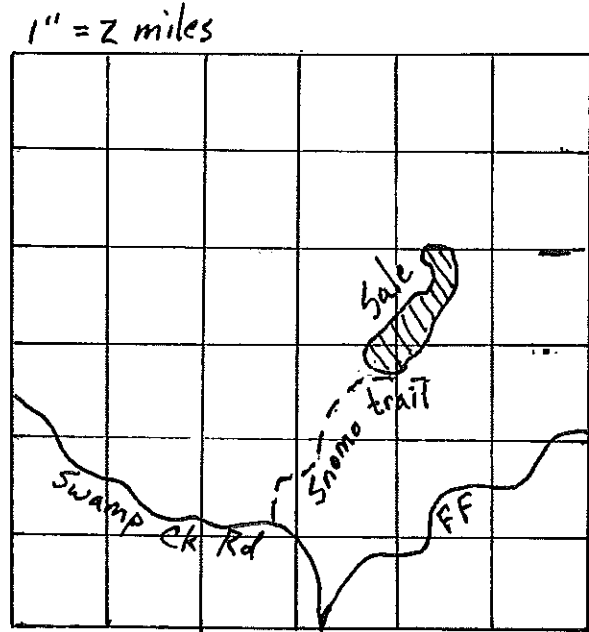

Cut all trees marked with orange paint in this plantation second thinning. Also cut all merchantable Balsam Fir & aspen. Utilize all soft wood pulpwood to a 3" top and hardwoods to 4" top DIB. Leave all white birch, maples and spruce for wildlife and diversity. Leave all snags and cull trees for wildlife that are not a safety hazard and any hollow logs that are cut must be left where felled. The remainder of the tree that is sound maybe utilized. All slash and fire laws shall be followed. New roads and landings must have approval from Iron County before construction and WI BMP's for water quality followed. Access road crosses wetland and may need a permit if improved for summer logging. 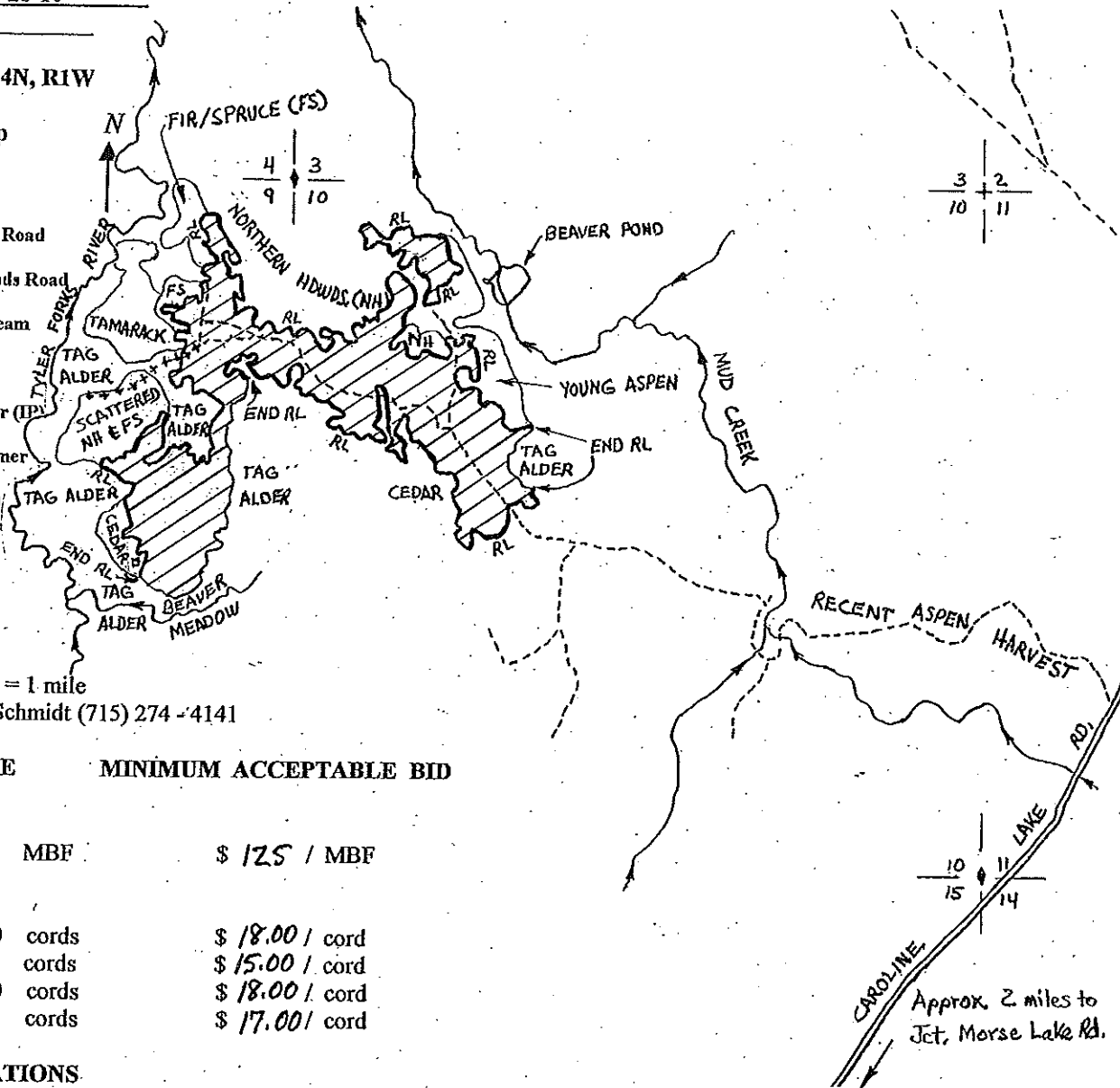

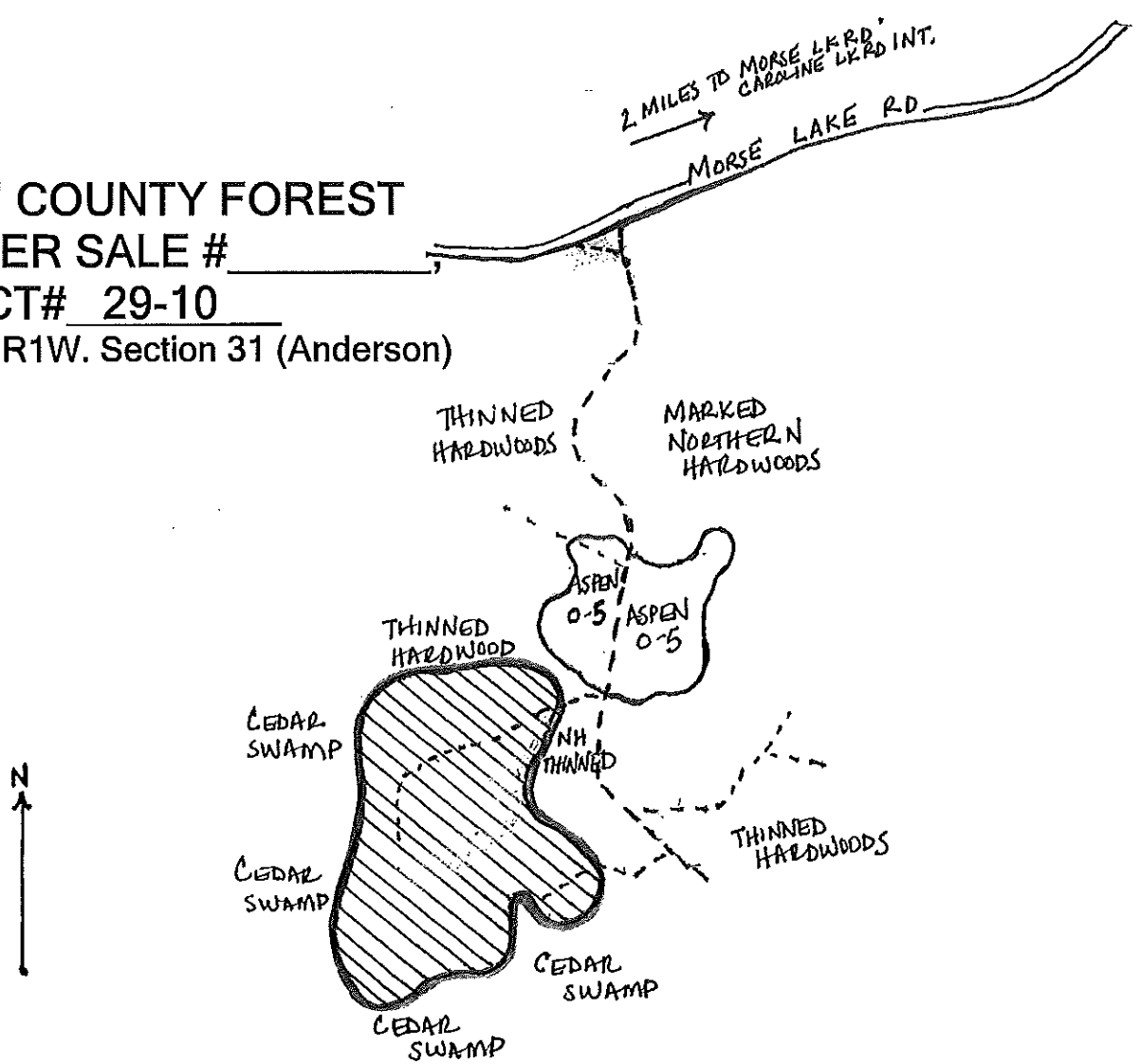

Utilize hardwood sawlogs to a 10-inch minimum DIB top and pulpwood to a 4-inch minimum DOB top.

GENERAL SALE OPERATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

New roads must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Existing roads and trails shall be kept free of debris and restored to original condition prior to sale close-out. Excessive rutting or residual stand damage will result in sale suspension or closure. Protect the old cabin site located near the sale's *southwestern* boundary.
