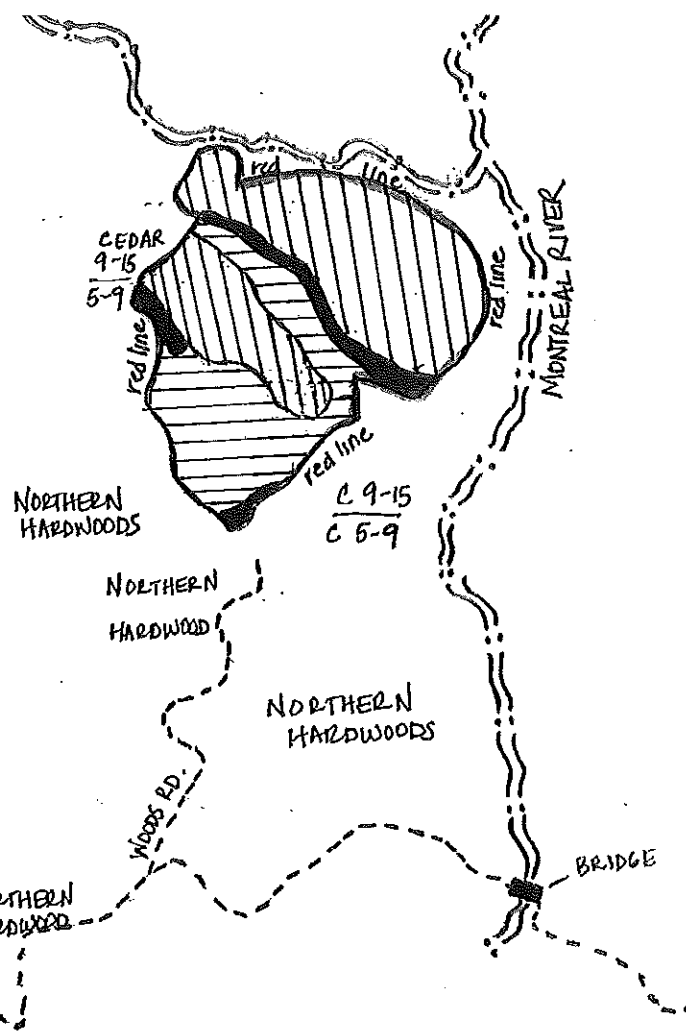

**Harvest Specifications:**

**ZONE 1:** Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a 10 inch minimum top diameter. Prevent damage to residual timber at all costs. Leave existing snags standing. Prevent and minimize rutting. Follow all BMP's. No logging from March through December.

**ZONE 2:** Harvest all mixed hardwoods yielding < 9.5" DBH. Harvest all Balsam Fir that yield at least 1 100" pulpstick. Utilize all tops of pulpwood to a 4" top. No cutting of Cedar, Black and White Spruce, White Pine and Hemlock. Leave all snags standing. Prevent and minimize rutting at all costs. Follow all BMP's. No logging from March through December.

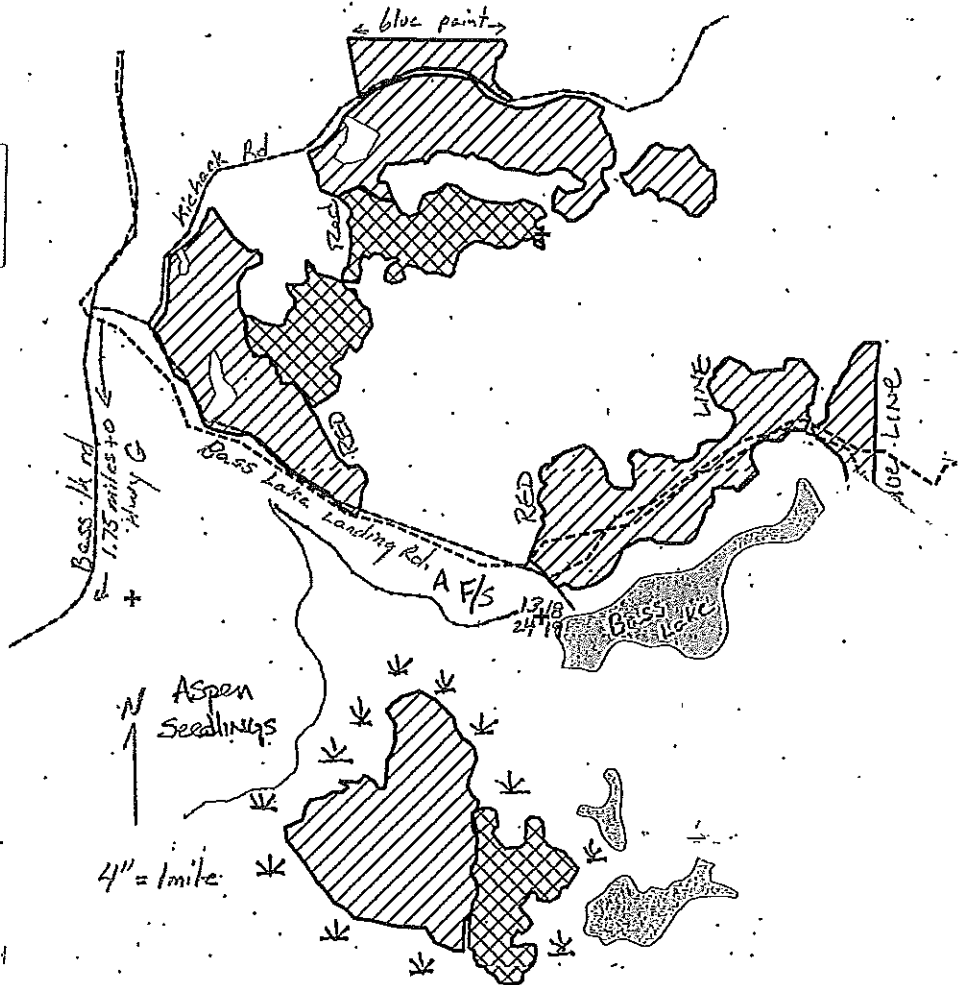

**CUTTING REQUIREMENTS:**

This sale is accessed via Bass Lake road. The sale boundaries are distinguished by a red paint line. Property boundaries to the N and E are painted blue. The terrain is gently rolling. All survey markers must be protected from logging damage. No felling trees across, piling slash or tree tops over the blue line. All new roads and landings must have approval from Iron County Forestry before construction and WI BMP's for water quality followed. Utilize all pulpwood to a minimum 4-inch top diameter and all sawtimber to a 10-inch minimum top diameter (hardwoods)/9 inch (softwoods).

**Northern Hardwood 117 acres:** Cut all orange marked trees, including those trees marked less than 4" in diameter. Cut all aspen and balsam fir containing one or more 100-inch pulpsticks. Restrict skidding trails to protect NH and hemlock advanced regeneration. **NO HARVEST ACTIVITY APRIL → JUNE**

**Even Aged CC areas 33 acres:** Cut all trees 2" and greater, utilize all trees with one or more pulp sticks, except do not cut or damage any white pine, hemlock, cedar or oak.

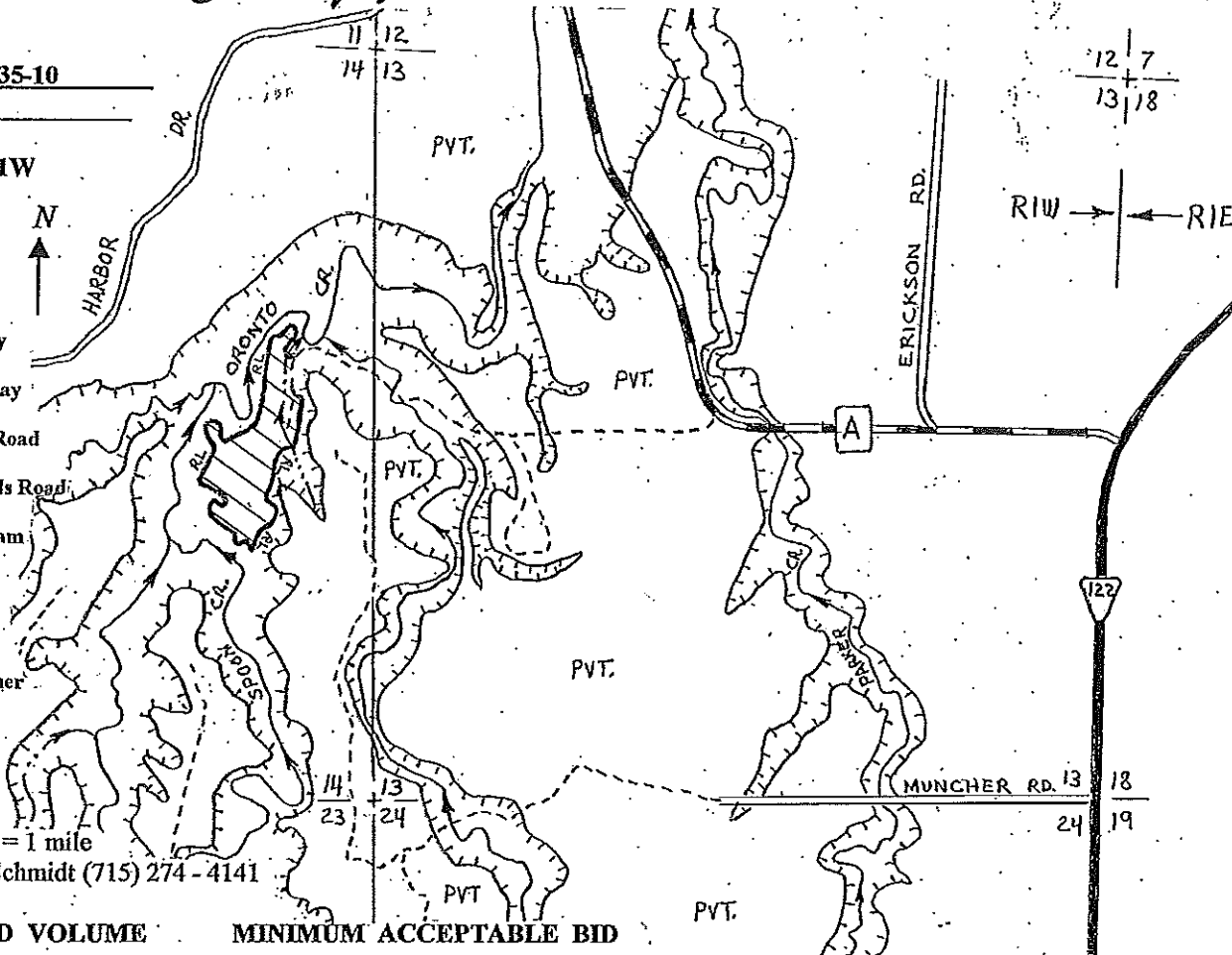

TRACT IS SFI & FSC CERTIFIED

Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all hardwoods (except oak and cherry); and aspen (designated) containing 1 or more 100-inch pulpsticks. Retain all oak, cherry and conifers except for marked spruce. Every 5<sup>th</sup> row of this plantation has all trees painted with vertical orange marks providing minimum 10-ft wide logging access lanes. Utilize hardwood sawlogs to a 10-inch minimum DIB top and pulpwood to a 4-inch minimum DOB top.

**Harvest Specifications:** Utilize pulpwood to a 4" top diameter and sawlogs to a 10" top diameter. Do not operate equipment where rutting will occur. Portions of the sale will need to be cut during frozen ground conditions. Follow Wisconsin BMP's at all times.

**Clear Cut Area (23 acres):** Harvest all trees except oak, hemlock, pine, and cedar. Snags and wildlife trees may be left standing. Cull material may be left in the woods.

**Select Cut Area (88 acres):** Harvest all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen, white birch, balsam, and spruce. Avoid damage to residual trees. No logging during April, May, or June.

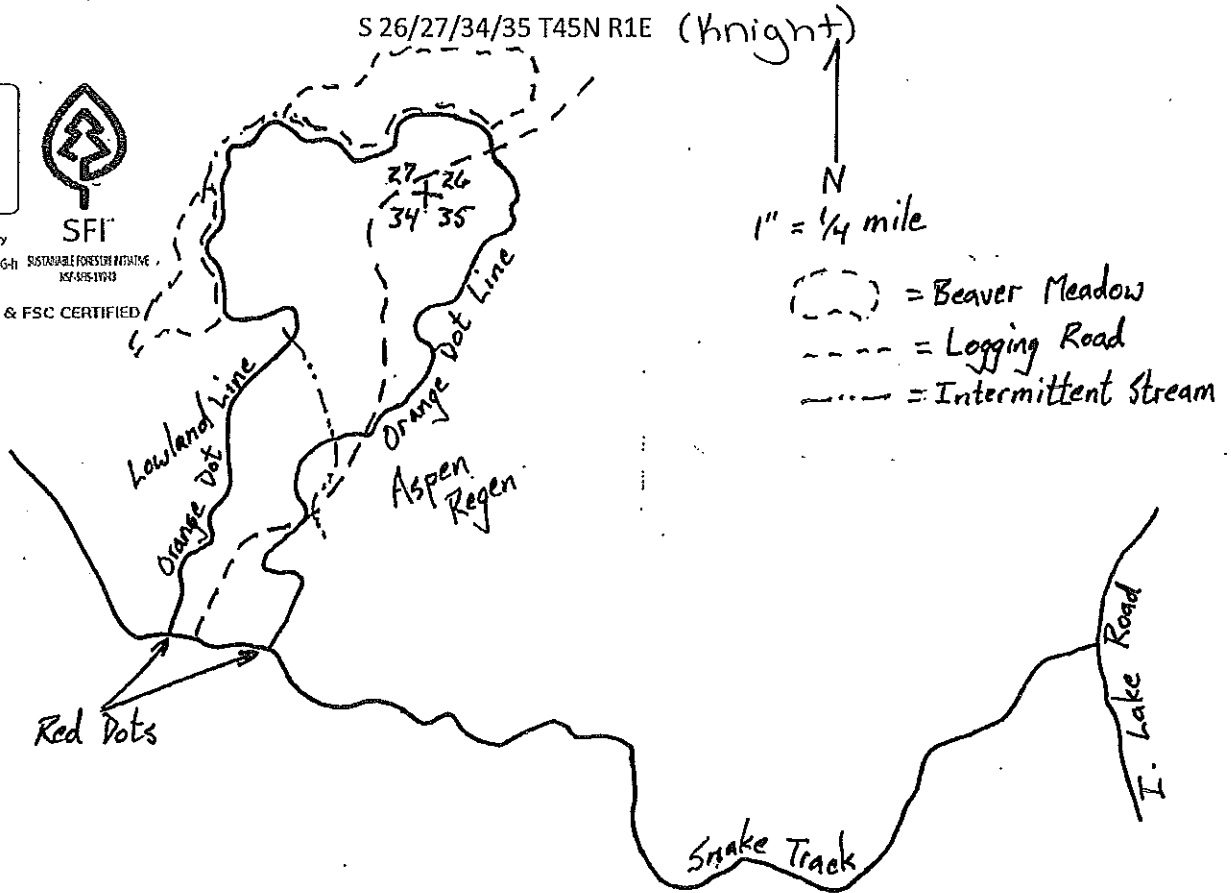

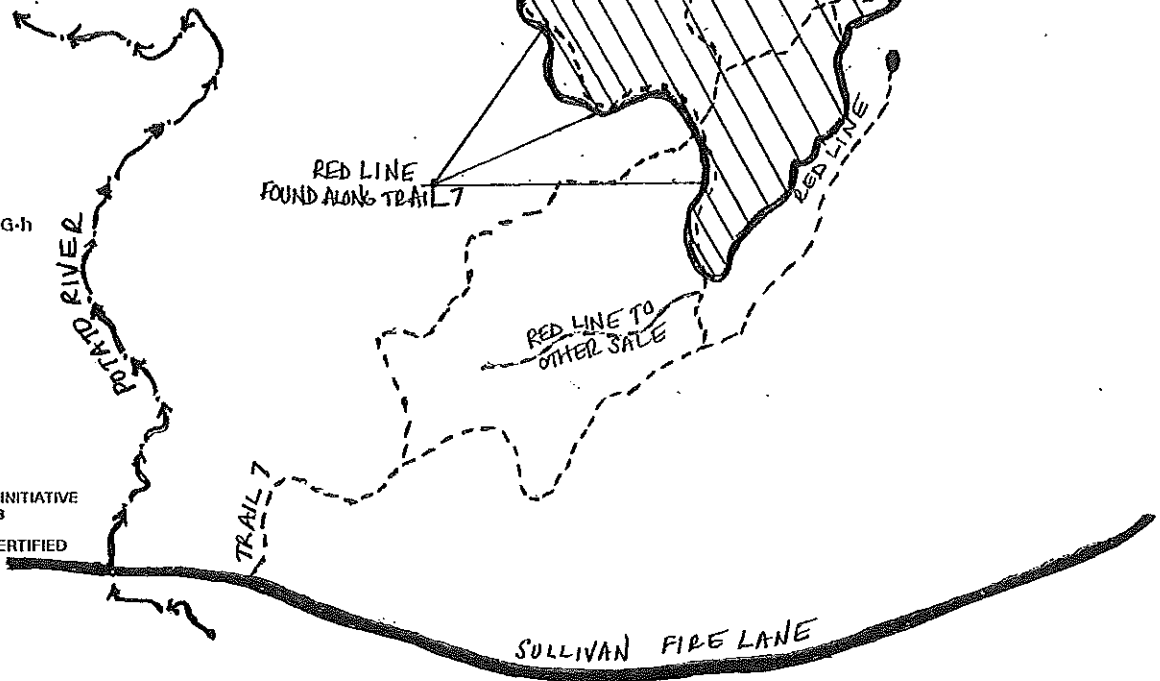

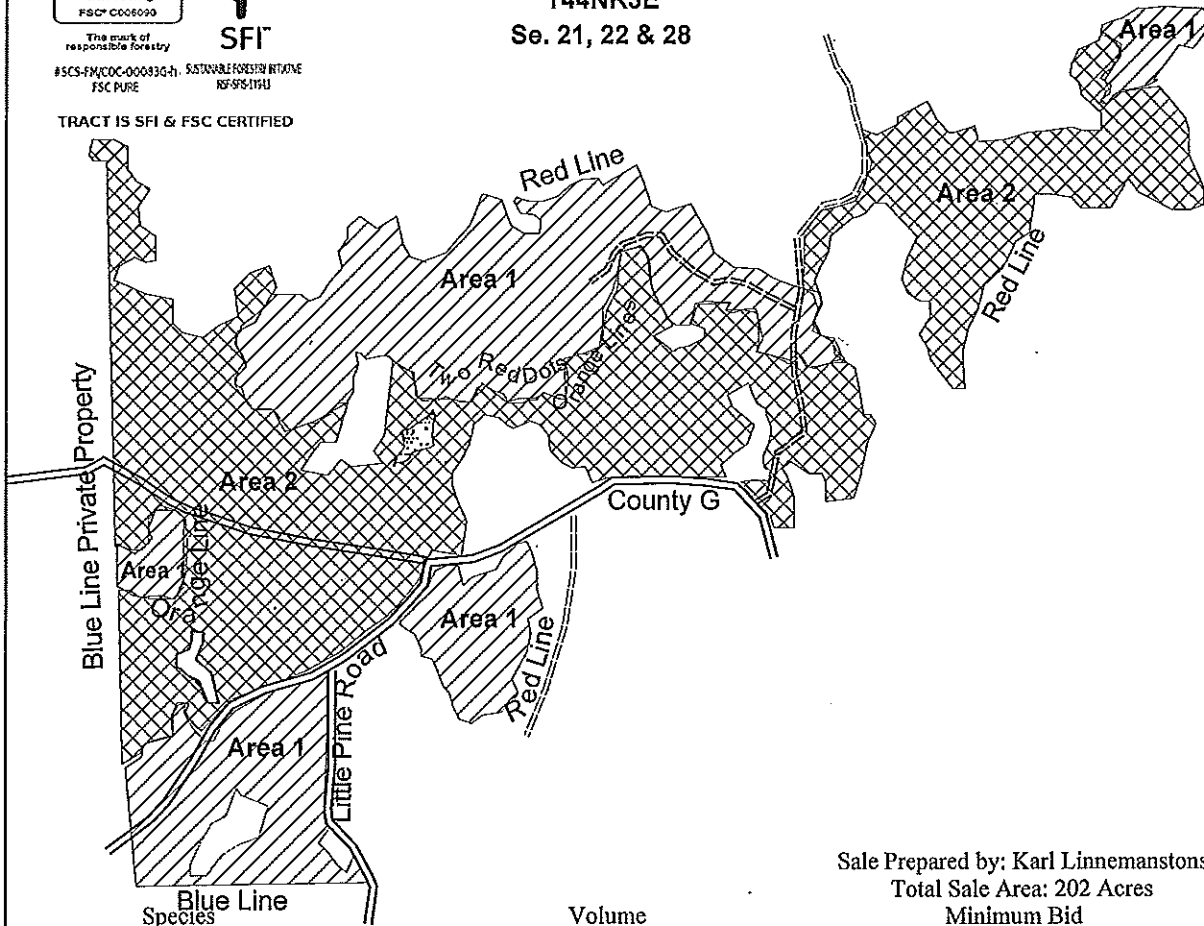
