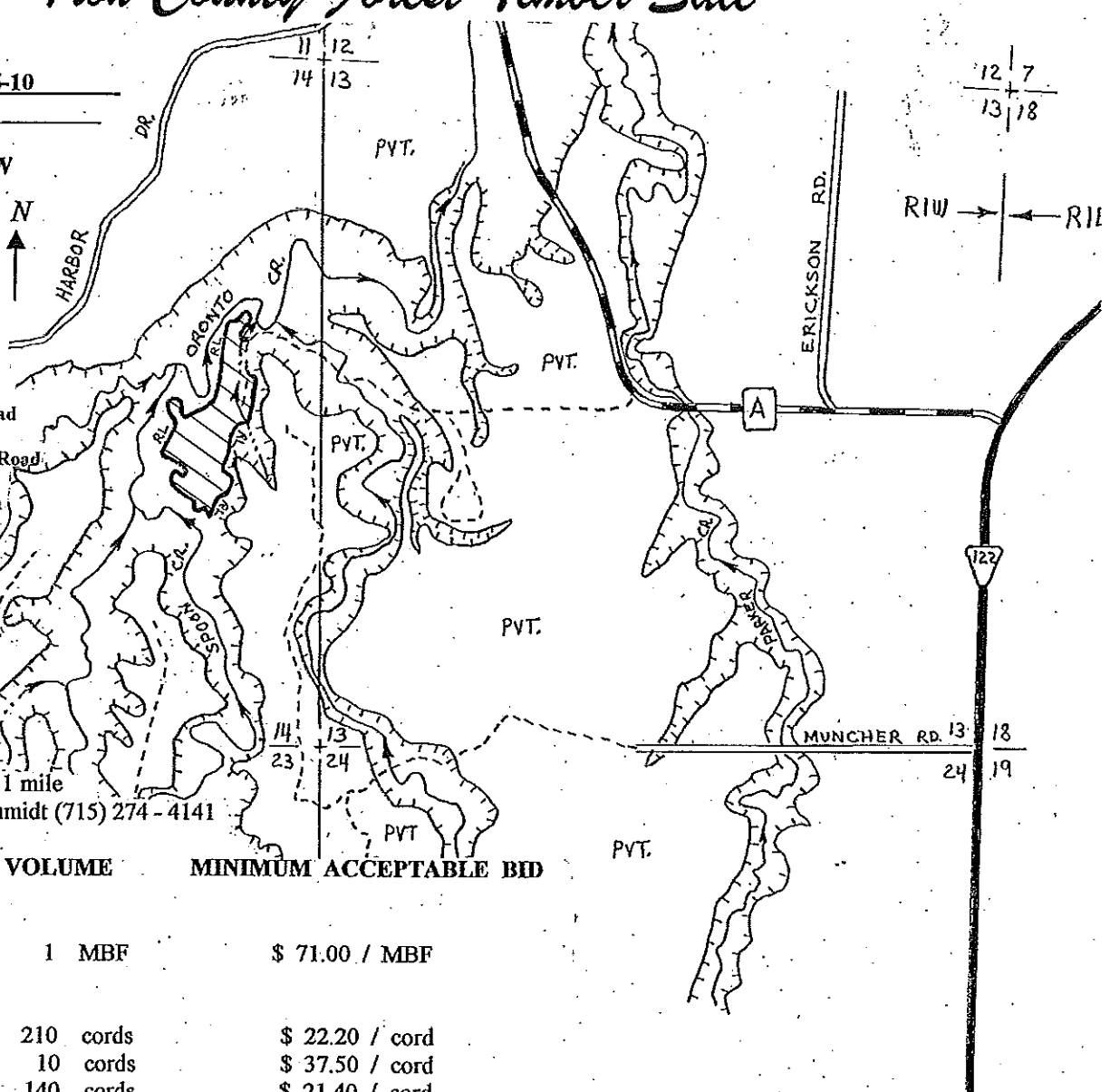

HARVEST SPECIFICATIONS

Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all hardwoods (except oak and cherry); and aspen (designated) containing 1 or more 100-inch pulpsticks. Retain all oak, cherry and conifers except for marked spruce. Every 5th row of this plantation has all trees painted with vertical orange marks providing minimum 10-ft wide logging access lanes. Utilize hardwood sawlogs to a 10-inch minimum DIB top and pulpwood to a 4-inch minimum DOB top.

GENERAL SALE OPERATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

No logging during April, May or June. New roads must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Existing roads and trails shall be kept free of debris and restored to original condition prior to sale close-out. Excessive rutting or residual stand damage will result in sale suspension or closure. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Water Quality shall be implemented in all phases of the sale. Private lands must be crossed to access this sale.

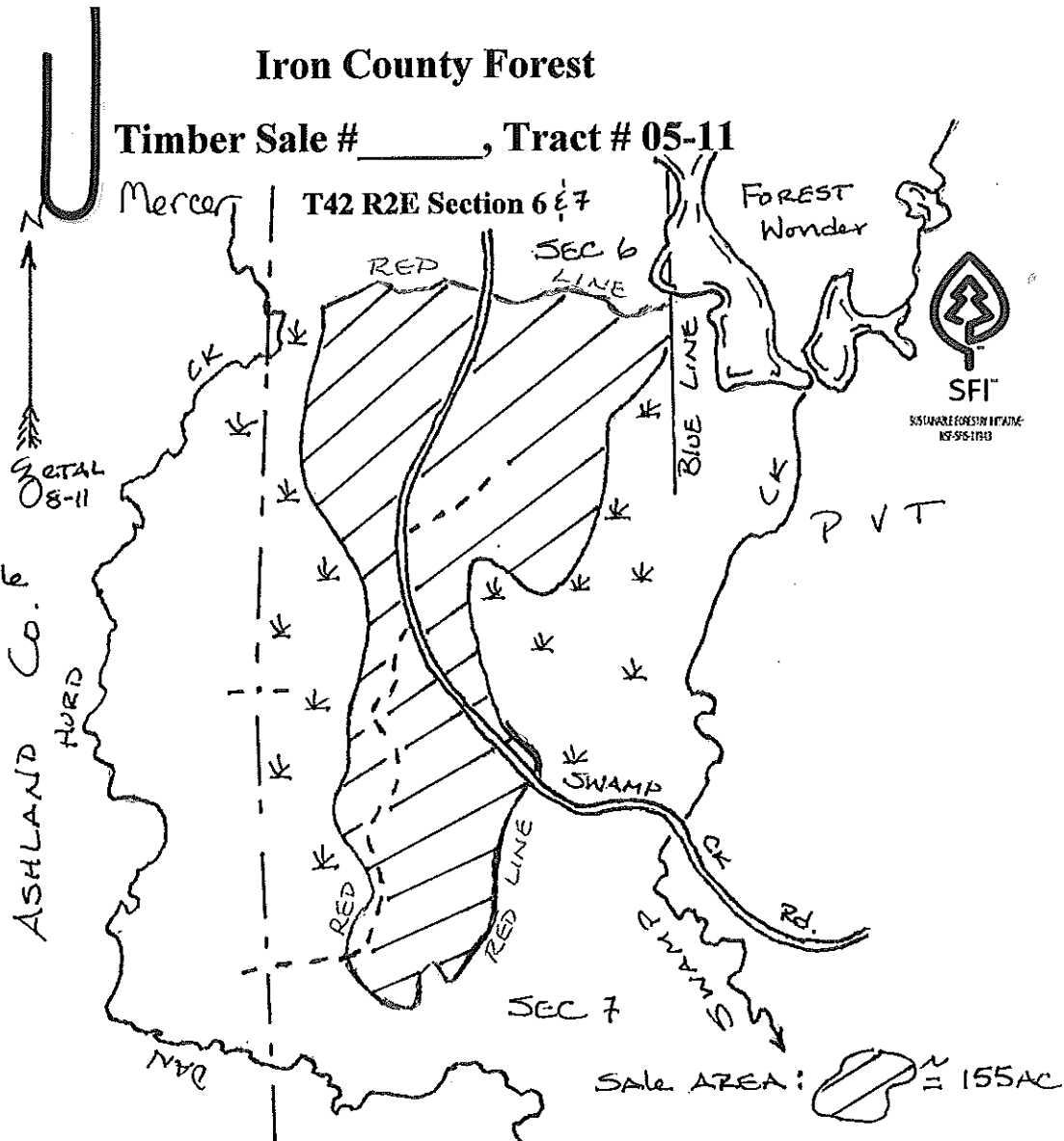

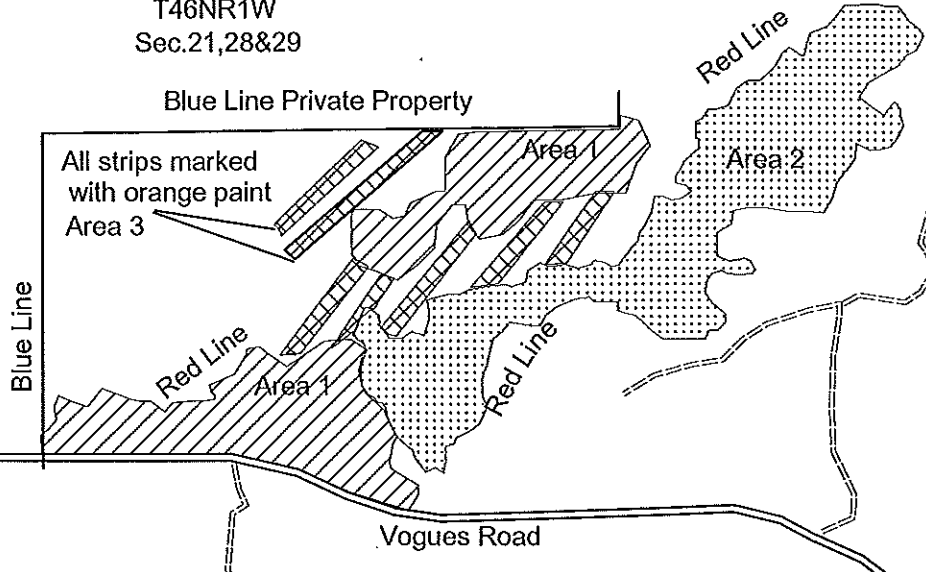

Harvest Specifications Area 1 (55 acres)

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint along with all aspen, balsam fir, and spruce. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Piece along road can be harvested at anytime except April 1st thru July 1st.

Harvest Specifications Area 2 (67 acres)

Harvest all balsam fir, spruce, aspen, and trees > 10 inches dbh. Leave all cedar, hemlock, and pine. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Can only be harvested from December 1st thru March.

Harvest Specifications Area 3 (9 acres)

Harvest everything 2 inches dbh and up, except for cedar, hemlock, and pine. The strips are approximately 66 feet wide and approximately 132 feet apart. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Can only be harvested from December 1st thru March.

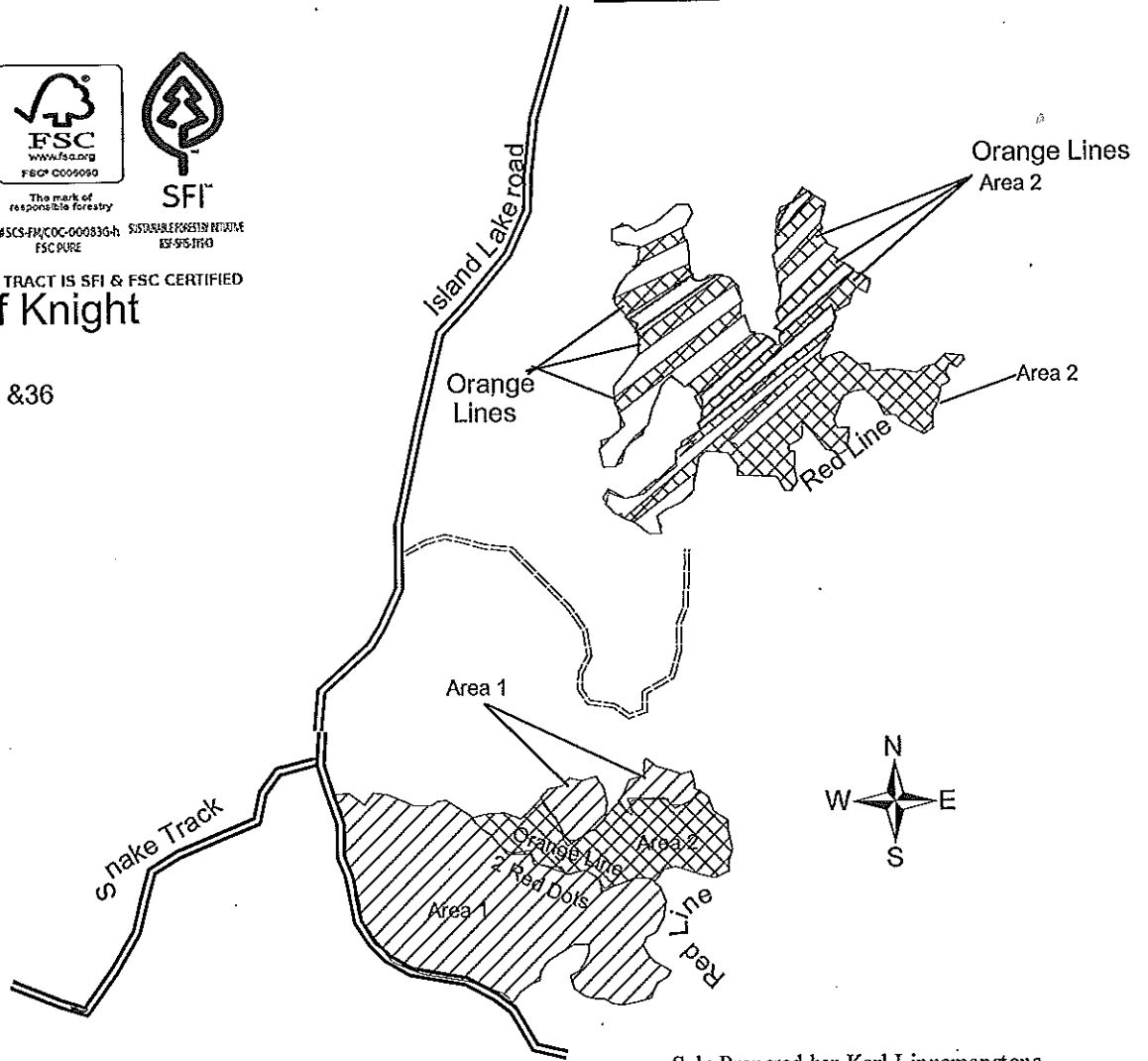

Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Sale area boundaries are solid red paint line, two red dots and the road. Harvesting may only take place December thru March.

Harvest Specifications Area 2 (39 acres)

Harvest everything 2 inches dbh and up, except for hemlock and pine. The strips are approximately 66 feet wide and approximately 100 feet apart. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Sale area boundaries are solid orange paint line and red line. Harvesting may only take place December thru March.

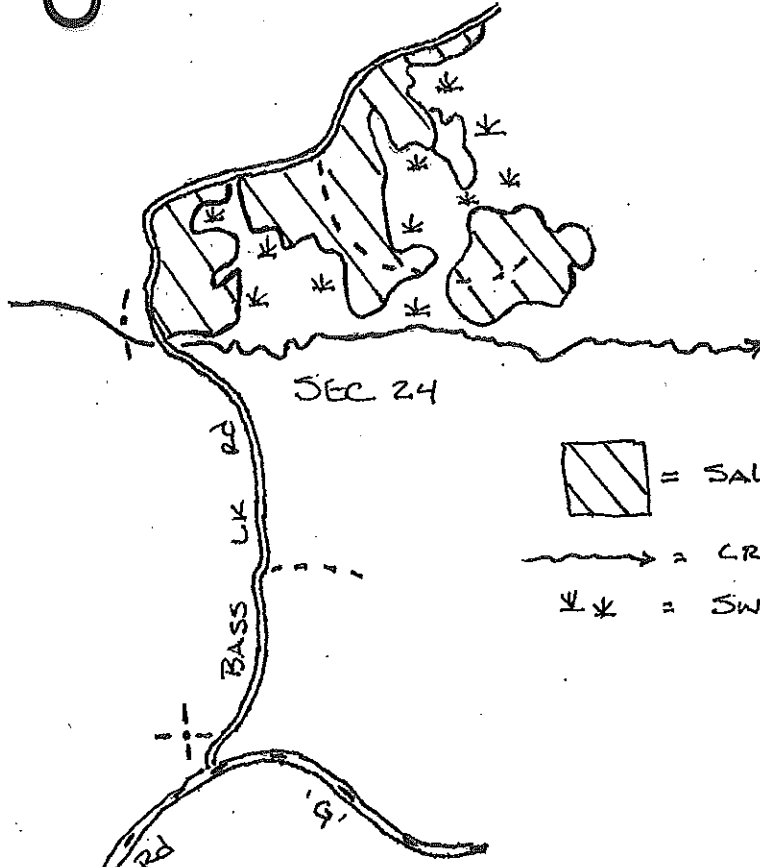

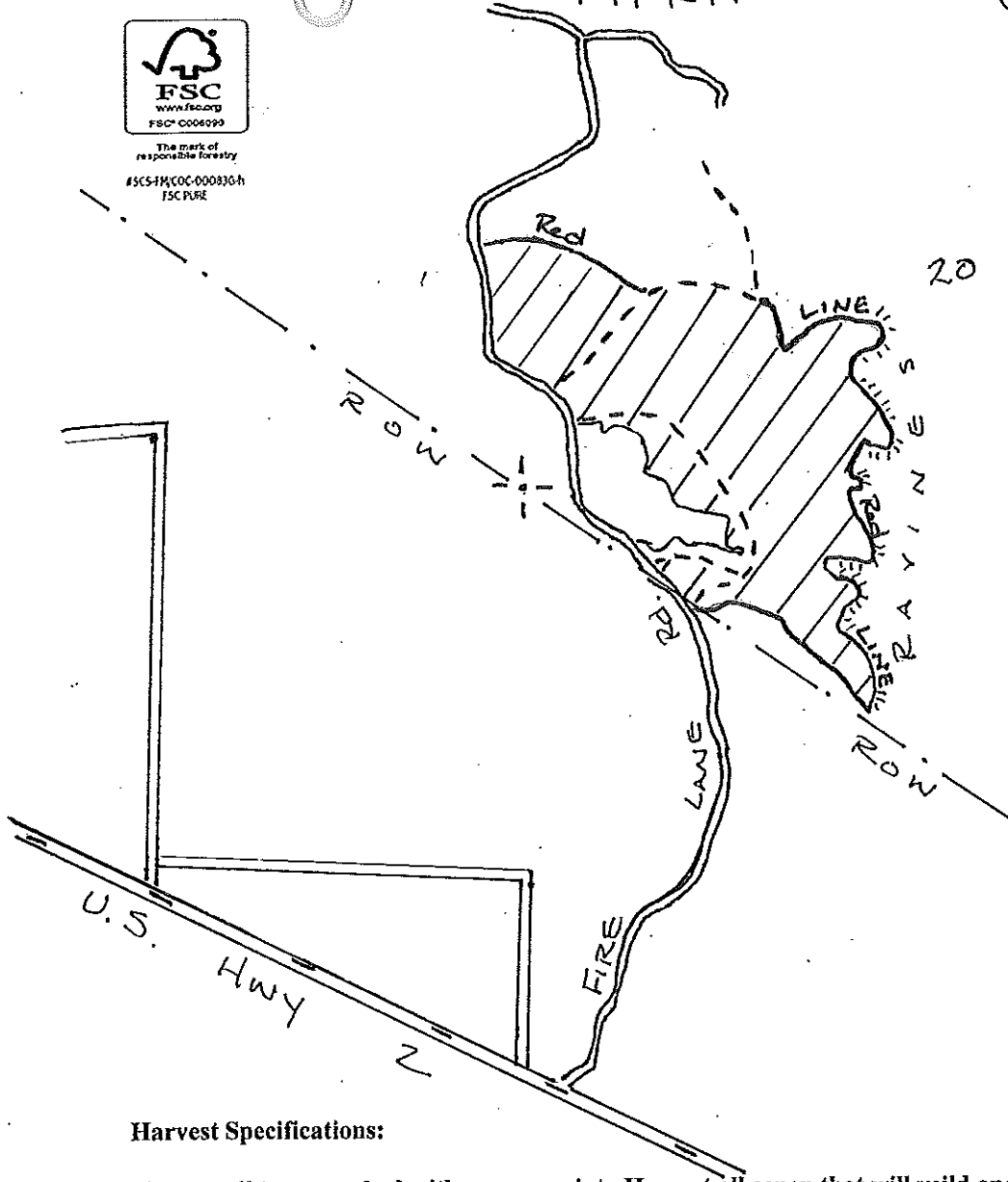

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Harvest all aspen that will yield one 100" pulp stick. Utilize pulpwood to a 4" minimum top diameter, saw timber to a 10" minimum top diameter. No harvest activity from April to July. Current Wisconsin BMP's for water and soil quality are in effect. Prevent rutting at all costs. Protect residual stems (especially hemlock) from logging damage. Snags will be left standing unless safety is compromised.

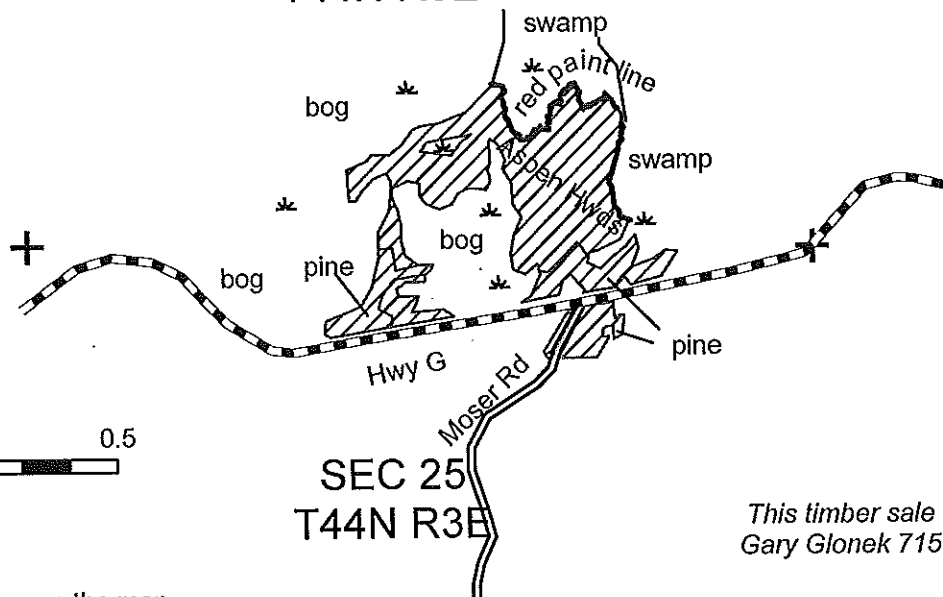

Cut all Aspen, Mixed Hardwood, Spruce and Balsam containing one or more 100 inch pulpstick to a 4 inch minimum top diameter. Cut only those Red Pine marked with orange paint. Do not cut White Pine, Cedar or Hemlock. There is a small drainage in the Red Pine plantation which is only to be crossed in one place with a drainage structure which must be removed following logging. Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of wetland areas except during frozen ground conditions. Eliminate rutting and do not leave tops in wetland areas.

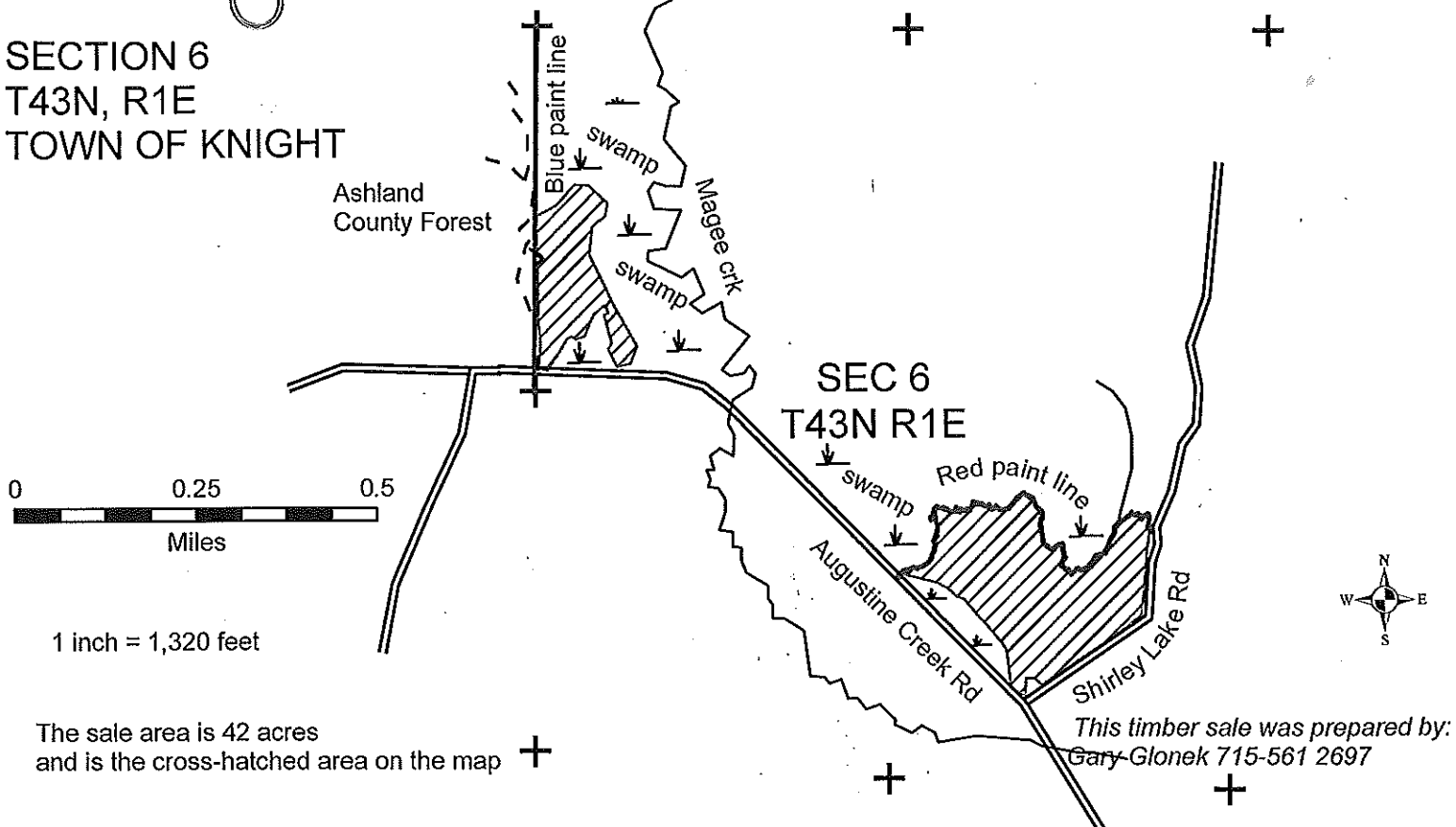
